

# **Trophy Book Archery Ltd presents "Virtual Challenge."**

A Virtual Archery Shooting Competition open to all ages and Shooting styles.

## **Rules and Regulations**

### **Book Shooting Times and Qualify**

To ensure your opportunity to enter, it is recommended that competitors call Trophy Book Archery to reserve a time to shoot "TechnoHUNT" to post a score and qualify. Book Times during normal business hours – Tuesday to Friday from 10:00a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m.

### **Registration and Game Cards**

Registration Fees are \$10 per Category. Competitors must register at Trophy Book Archery between December 1, 2010 and March 25, 2011 during normal business hours. A Game Card will be issued to each Competitor for each Category to keep track of the Game Sets Shot. Trophy Book Archery will keep the Game Cards on file. Registrations are not transferable or refundable.

### **Qualify a Game Set**

Competitors who have registered and shoot TechnoHUNT "Virtual Challenge" Games qualify to enter a score and have the Game Set posted on the Category Posting Board. Shoot as often as you want. Qualifying must be done before 7:00 p.m. – Friday, March 25, 2011.

### **Shooting a Game Set**

Shooting a "Virtual Challenge" Game of 45 screens is a Game Set. There are 10 "Virtual Challenge" Game Sets numbered 1 to 10. Competitors must shoot the first ten Game Sets before they can reshoot the Game Set Sequence. There is no order to shooting the Game Set 1 to 10. Competitors are responsible for the validity of the Game Set Stamp on the correct Category Game Card.

### **Up to 3 Competitors per Game Set**

The program "TechnoHUNT" can track and record up to three shooters at a time. This allows a Competitor to shoot with up to two other Competitors in the same Game Set as a Group. All Competitors in the Group must shoot the same Game Set and must follow the Rules of "Shooting a Game Set."

### **Game Fees to Shoot a Game Set and Post a Score**

Each time a competitor shoots, they must pay the following Game Fee per Game Set Shot. They may shoot as many times as they like either alone or with others. The fees charged per Game Set is;

First time Competitor Shoots	\$50.00 Game Fee
To shoot a Game Set again	\$25.00 each time

## **Catagories**

There are four Categories available. Competitors can shoot in more than one category, if they qualify, but must register for each Category and pay a Registration Fee for each category.

**Expert** – Open to both Male and Female Competitors of All Ages.

- Both Traditional and Compound Bows can be used.
- Bows must be 70 pound Draw Weights and Less.
- Arrows must have 100 grain blunts or higher.
- Total Arrow weight must be no less than 5 grains per pound of Draw Weight.
- Competitors shoot the Game Sets with both the "True Yardage" and the "Windage" Options in play.
- Competitors must allow sufficient time to shoot a Setup Screen and have their Arrows weighed to play. TechnoHUNT records the information for future games. Any changes to draw weight and arrow weight are the Competitors responsibility to have updated.

**Compound** - Open to both Male and Female Competitors 18 years old and older.

- Only Compound Bows can be used.
- Bows must be 70 pound Draw Weights and Less.
- Arrows must have 100 grain blunts or higher.
- Total Arrow weight must be no less than 5 grains per pound of Draw Weight.
- Competitors shoot the Game Sets without either of the "True Yardage" or "Windage" Options in play.

**Traditional** - Open to both Male and Female Competitors 18 years old and older.

- Only Traditional Bows can be used.
- Bows must be 70 pound Draw Weights and Less.
- Arrows must have 100 grain blunts or higher.
- Total Arrow weight must be no less than 5 grains per pound of Draw Weight.
- Competitors shoot the Game Sets without either of the "True Yardage" or "Windage" Options in play.

**Junior** – Open to both Male and Female Competitors under 18 years of age.

- Both Traditional and Compound Bows can be used.
- Bows must be 70 pound Draw Weights and Less.
- Arrows must have 100 grain blunts or higher.
- Total Arrow weight must be no less than 5 grains per pound of Draw Weight.
- Competitors shoot the Game Sets without either of the "True Yardage" or "Windage" Options in play.

**Shoot Off**

The Top 3 Scoring Competitors in each Category will participate in a shoot off on Saturday, March 26, 2011. Trophy Book Archery will call successful Competitors with Shoot-off Times which are expected to start at 10:00 a.m. Finalists unable to attend, unable to be reached and/or absent when the Shoot-off is ready to start will be Disqualified and the next highest Score will be allowed to compete in the Final Shoot-off for the prize money. Shoot-off Rounds are about 50 minutes each.

**Equipment Failure**

If the TechnoHUNT program fails due to power outage and/or program shutdown, Competitors will be refunded their Game Fee.

**Equipment Calibration**

The TechnoHUNT program will be calibrated as often as may be necessary to ensure the accuracy of the arrows shot.

**Protests**

All protests will go before a rules committee. No protest will be heard until a \$50.00 protest fee is paid in cash to the protest committee. All decisions of the protest committee are final.

**Crossbows**

Crossbows are not permitted to be shot in the "Virtual Challenge" Competition.

**General Information**

Trophy Book Archery Management reserves the right to refuse a person from entering the Competition with or without reason.

Trophy Book Archery Management will make every effort to contact Competitors in the Final Shoot-off by phone.

Competitors will act in a positive and safe manner anytime they are on the premises of Trophy Book Archery Ltd. Competitors shooting unsafe equipment and /or shooting unsafely will be disqualified from the "Virtual Challenge" Competition and will forfeit any and all monies paid to date. Competitors causing damage to Trophy Book Archery Ltd. equipment and/or property may face prosecution.
